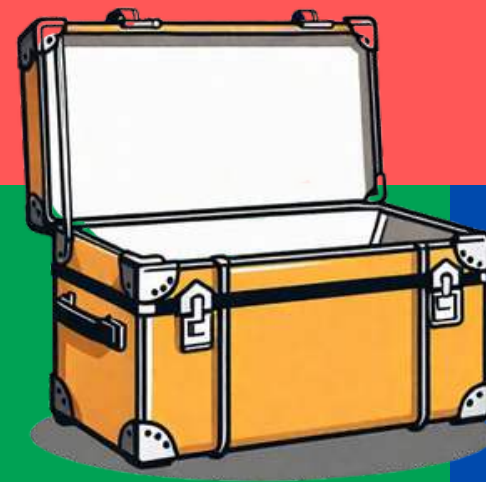

- 2-3 labelled water bottles\*
- Flip flops
- 2 Pairs of sneakers
- 1 Pair of closed toe shoes i.e. crocs
- 2 Pairs of pajamas
- 2 Bathing suits
- 7 Pair of cotton socks
- 1 Pair heavy wool socks
- 7 Pair underwear
- 4 Pairs of shorts
- 7 Cotton t-shirts\*
- 2 Pairs of long pants
- Sweatshirt and sweatpants\*
- Wool or polar fleece outerwear
- Waterproof raingear or poncho\*
- Lined jacket
- Hat\*

### TRIP GEAR NEEDED FOR MIDLERS AND SENIORS (FOR OPTIONAL HIKING TRIPS)



- Wool or polar fleece sweater
- Waterproof raingear including pants
- Cap with visor
- Hiking boots (broken in)
- 2-3 pair heavy socks (one wool)
- 2-3 Moisture-wicking shirts
- Lightweight long sleeved shirt\*
- Non-denim long pants
- Sleeping bag with stuff sack
- Backpack (optional)
- Plastic, screw top water bottle\*
